ELECTIONS OF DELEGATES FOR BARGAINING COMMITTEE AT CAUCUS

Elections will be conducted at the **Caucus** on September 23, 2026 at the conclusion of the days' business.

ELECTION PROCESS

1. There will be three (3) Bargaining Committee Representatives for the Ontario Region.
2. The Representation areas are as follows:
 - South/West: Locals 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 4747, 48
 - North/East: Locals 29-X, 30-O, 31, 34-O, 36, 37, 38, 39-O, 40-O, 49
 - GTA: Locals 25, 26, 27, 28

Each Local will have only one (1) voting delegate.

3. Candidates, nominators and voting delegates must be Transervice Bargaining Unit Members in good standing of one of the Locals in the respective representative areas.
4. Nominations will take place at Caucus and there is no requirement that nominations be seconded. Acceptance to nomination can be made verbally or by way of letter stating you will stand for the position.
5. Candidates will have an opportunity to make a brief presentation to the voting delegates.
